**CollegeInvest Wyoming to award \$3,000 in scholarships**  
*Kids under 12 can enter to win money for higher education*

Wyoming kids under the age of 12 have the chance to win \$1,000 for their college education.

CollegeInvest Wyoming is kicking off a new scholarship contest, giving kids across the state an opportunity to creatively express their career dreams and possibly win some college cash.

CollegeInvest will award \$1,000 college savings plan starter accounts to three winners selected from Wyoming kids who submit an answer the question: “What do you want to be when you grow up and how would a college education help make that possible?”

This is the first Wyoming scholarship contest offered by CollegeInvest since announcing the Colorado-Wyoming partnership last summer that made the popular Colorado 529 college savings plans available to Wyoming residents.

CollegeInvest Wyoming will select one winner from each of three age categories: ages 0-6, ages 7-9 and ages 10-12. The response to the question can be in the form of an essay, 250 words or less, or a drawing depicting the answer.

The \$3,000 in total winnings will be awarded in the form of CollegeInvest 529 college savings plan accounts. Money saved through these college savings plans can be used nationwide at any eligible public or private colleges, universities and vocational schools for qualified higher education expenses such as tuition, fees, certain room and board and required supplies.
